Continuing Student Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) Grant Application Form

The Opus College of Business offers a limited amount of tuition assistance each semester (fall and spring) to continuing **Evening UST MBA students who demonstrate financial need**. TAP grants are awarded on a semester basis for enrollment in College of Business graduate courses. Awards are for one semester only; students must resubmit the TAP application for each semester they request tuition assistance.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a TAP grant, you must:

- Be a continuing student in the Evening UST MBA program, having been enrolled previously in the most recent fall or spring semester
- Be a US citizen or resident alien
- File a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) prior to the application deadline
- Be a student in good academic standing (cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above)

To apply for the Tuition Assistance Program, please submit this application form and attach a short statement of your reasons for requesting tuition assistance. In this statement, include an explanation of any special circumstances that the committee should consider in reviewing your application.
